DOUBLING

Much doubling is possible with this play and almost all extra roles (and even some of the 13 holiday celebrities) can be played as male or female. Below is just a sample of how you could use doubling to cut down the non-holiday celebrity roles so that they could all be played by just six actors. There are many other possibilities to suit almost all sizes of casts.

Actor 1: Max (Sc. 2), Hammerstein (Sc. 3,4,6), Guard (Sc. 8)

Actor 2: Harry (Sc. 2), Rodgers (Sc. 3.10), Bailiff (Sc. 6,7)

Actor 3: Jessica (Sc. 3), Maude (Sc. 6), INS Agent (Sc. 8)

Kenny's Mom (Sc. 9), Mrs. Campbell (Sc. 10)

Actor 4: Gretel (Sc. 5), Judge (Sc. 6,7), Mary (Sc. 10)

Actor 5: Det. Gilbert (Sc. 5), Frank (Sc. 6), Kenny (Sc. 9),

Father (Sc. 10)

Actor 6: Det. Sullivan (Sc. 5), Baker (Sc. 7), Billy (Sc. 10)

COSTUMES

TURKEY, SANTA, and EASTER BUNNY: Black and white-striped prison shirts in addition to their normal costumes.

MAX: Elf costume with a funny hat with a bell on the end, tights, and soft shoes with curled-up toes.

GILBERT AND SULLIVAN: Suits.

CUPID: Leisure suit with wings.

MOTHER NATURE: Floral apparel with leaves and birds in her hair.

FATHER TIME: A scraggily-looking old man with a very long beard and tinted sunglasses looking something like Jerry Garcia.

LEPRECHAUN: Dressed like all leprechauns, green tights, beard, and a big green hat with a gold shamrock on it.

BABY: Unitard overlaid with a bib, and a giant diaper, optional bonnet.
